Canonisation of John Henry Newman (1801-1890)

John Henry Newman C.O. was a theologian and a poet, first an Anglican priest then later a Catholic priest and a cardinal, who was an important and controversial figure in the religious history of England in the 19th century. His writings continue to reflect a rich theology. He was also founder of the Oratorians. On Sunday October 13th, Blessed John Henry Newman will be declared a Saint by Pope Francis. Blessed Henry Newman was founder of the first Irish Catholic university in Ireland.

and holy rest, and peace at the last.'


